Pope Francis' Monthly Prayer Intention - September 2024 - For the cry of the Earth.

We pray that each one of us will hear and take to heart the cry of the Earth and of victims of natural disasters and climactic change, and that all will undertake to personally care for the world in which we live.

Blessed Carlo Acutis relic at Portlaoise Parish Church, Sept 11th-13th.

A relic of blessed Carlo Acutis will be the central feature of series of special liturgies and prayer services in Ss. Peter & Pauls Church, Portlaoise this week. The relic is being brought to Ireland during September by Franciscan friars from Assisi where his mortal remains repose. There will be an official 'reception of the relic' on Wednesday at 7.00pm. Bishop Nulty will be principal celebrant at the 10am mass on Thursday. Throughout Thursday & Friday there will be talks on Carlo's life and blessing with the relic before a farewell prayer service at 3.00pm Friday. All welcome.

Say to all faint hearts 'Courage Do not be Afraid'.

This week's readings invite us to celebrate our 'unbounded admiration' (Gospel) for the Lord who 'keeps faith with us for ever' (Psalm). Our God makes no distinction between classes of people, desiring to nourish us and set us all free. In the Gospel Jesus not only heals the deaf man with a speech impediment, but also opens the ears of many to faith, and loosens tongues to spread the Good News of the kingdom. This week, we pray to be open to God's love – the God who wants to work in and through us, healing and transforming us individually, as communities, and in our institutions.

MISSIONARIES OF AFRICA (White Fathers) This weekend we welcome Fr. Neil Loughrey M. Afr. to speak about the mission and work of the White Fathers. Founded in 1868 by Cardinal Charles Lavigerie, from the start he had in mind the witness of Christian love to the Muslims of North Africa and the evangelization of the peoples of sub-Saharan Africa. Today the White Fathers are present in 44 countries worldwide, of which 23 are in Africa.
