12 noon—A water ritual, with water from the Grotto of Lourdes.

3pm—Mass for the Sick and the Sacrament of the Sick.

6pm —Stations of the Cross.

8pm—Torch light procession: Assembling at Carlow College, St. Patrick's for procession to the Cathedral for Rosary and Marian Devotion.

10pm—The visit of the relics concluding with a prayer of thanksgiving.

The Relics may be visited throughout the day in the Cathedral.
