Advent

Today we celebrate the First Sunday of Advent – the beginning of a new liturgical year. This is our great season of waiting and preparing for the Lord. Maranatha – 'Come, Lord Jesus' is the traditional prayer of Advent. The prayer is a cry to Jesus to come into our lives and into our hearts. To pray 'Come, Lord Jesus' is to recognise

that despite all that the world might seem to offer, it is Jesus who is the Lord of hope, peace, joy and love. As we journey through the Advent season let us take these weeks to turn to Jesus and to welcome Him into our lives, welcoming also the gifts of Hope, Peace, Joy and Love he offers to each of us.
