You will show me the path of life the fullness of joy in your presence. As we approach the end of the Church year, the readings challenge us to reflect on the 'End Times' and the hope we have in Christ. Today's Scripture reveals the fidelity of our God who stays with us through it all, encouraging us to remain faithful to God's love, even in difficult times. The poetic, symbolic language of the 1st Reading offers hope to those facing persecution. Jesus uses similar imagery in the Gospel to describe a world beset by turmoil and distress, just like our own. Jesus nevertheless assures his disciples (including us) of his constant presence and his ultimate victory. God's promises will be fulfilled: we can be confident in knowing that we will rejoice with Christ forever. This week, as we pray for each other, may we follow the Lord's path of life closely, showing it to others through the way we live our own lives.
