Lent our 40-day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving begins next Wednesday. It's a time of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries and extras during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully. Masses and distribution of blessed ashes will be at 7.30am, 10.00am and 7.30pm in the Parish Church and 8.00pm in Clonaghadoo.

DURING LENT JOIN US

TUESDAY Morning Mass: Beginning on Tuesday March 11th and continuing then on each Tuesday morning of Lent there will be a 7.30am mass in our Parish Church.

Station of the Cross for Lent: All are welcome each Sunday evening during Lent (beginning Sun 9th) at 7.00pm to the Parish Church for a praying of The Stations of the Cross.

After the 10am mass on the Fridays of Lent (beginning Fri 7th) there will be a short praying of the stations for those who are available to join in.

TROCAIRE - GUATEMALA - LENT 2025. Trócaire began working in Guatemala during the 1980s when the violence of the internal armed conflict was at its most extreme. The 2025 Lent campaign centres around the story of a family, and a small community, from La Paz. Ilma and Julio have four children and depend on farming for their livelihood. Like many families and communities, they are experiencing increasingly erratic weather patterns due to climate change. This is having life-changing consequences on their livelihoods, wellbeing and future. Help Trócaire help Ilma, Julio, their children and their community. The annual Lenten Trócaire Boxes are available to take home this weekend. Thank you.
