Our scripture readings this week encourage us to be compassionate, towards ourselves, towards others, and in all that we do. In the first we see how David does not give way to revenge when he finds Saul asleep, vulnerable and under his power. David has a choice, and acts with loyalty and restraint. Saul has persecuted him, but David now spares his life because Saul is the Lord's anointed one. In today's Gospel Jesus encourages us to love our enemies, to do good to those who hurt

us, to lend without expecting a reward, to love without counting the cost.
